Maximum number of participants: 250

Registration closes 30/04/2022

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Age of dog must exceed 18 months
- All competitions will take place under agility international rules & regulations. Categories S,M,L.
- Registration fee € 70,00 / dog
- The fee is due at the time of registration (<https://www.benacusopen.it/index.php/registration>) and is considered accepted once payment has been received
- For the dog, a valid vaccination booklet or certificate of vaccination is mandatory
- Handlers must maintain order and cleanliness of all public facilities and collect dropping of their dog/s
- Each handler is responsible for their own dog/s. The organisation and the property owner hosting the competition is not to be held responsible for damage caused to competitors or others during the event

QUALIFYING RACES:

Points will be awarded to each team based on their placement in the Agility & Jumping heats of the Friday and Saturday.

The result of the sum of the four placings in the qualifying matches, allocated according to the following table, will be the score that determines the right to participate in the Final.

BONUS POINTS

The first three finishers, with the clear run, of each qualifying round will be awarded bonus points (10 points for 1°, 6 points for 2° and 4 points for 3°)

THE GRAND FINAL

Based on the ranking given by the scores accumulated during the 4 qualifying heats (agility/jumping 1 and agility/jumping 2) 30% of the couples for each category qualify for the Final.

The first run of the final will be the jumping. Afterwards, based of the ranking of jumping, with reverse starting order, the agility run will take place.

The winners (the first in each category) of the BENACUS OPEN will be awarded on the combined ranking.
